Luke 1:78-79

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it." The fact is there is darkness in our world and in our lives. When we seem to be surrounded by darkness, let us look to Jesus for the light, instead of looking back at the darkness of the world, for Jesus will guide us through every dark corner of our lives. Regular Session Meeting November 25, 2024

The regular meeting of the Session of the 1st Presbyterian Church of Ashby met at 7 PM on November 25, 2024 at the church. Present were the Moderator Rev. Dr. Paul Snyder, Ruling Elders: Jim Rylander, Donna Fay Grover, Troy Johnson, Gwyn Risbrudt, Kim Bailey, Treasurer Jim Risbrudt and Clerk Barb Dewey. Absent with excuse Ron Bowman. The meeting was opened with prayer and devotions from Matthew 28 on the mission of the church to go and make disciples. Chapter 5 of Sailboat Church book was discussed. A quorum present. Docket amended and voted approved.

Treasurer's Report: Checking: \$1,780.53; Savings: \$19,964.86; Memorial: \$3,331.88; Music: \$7,962.51; Dishwasher: \$2,034.98; L&L Camp: \$1,481.13; Grover Bible: \$401.77; Build/Maint: \$6,701.00; Starner: \$2,764.39. Treasurer Jim reported he needed to withdraw \$1,000 of savings account to pay the \$7,100 insurance bill. The Fall Supper brought in \$3,000. A payment to the Shared Ministry in November was not needed because of their good balance on hand. The report was voted approved. The minutes of October 28 and November 12 meetings were voted approved.

Pastor's Report: Communion celebrated at Sunday service with Pastor Snyder on November 3, 2024 with 45 communicants and November 24 with 47 communicants and those on Facebook live. Pastor reports 4 Health Care center visitations, 1 home visit, led Bible Study at Ashby Living Center and attended Pastor's breakfast at Shoreline.

Committee Reports: Shared Ministry: Session and Our Saviors Ten Mile Lake Lutheran Council met November 12. Combined community churches Thanksgiving service will be at OS-TML on November 26 at 7 pm. Hanging of the Greens/WOW Christmas program will be at 1st Presbyterian December 8 at 10:30 AM with no service at OSTML. Blue Christmas at 1st Presbyterian on December 18 at 7 PM. Christmas Eve service at OS-TML at 5 PM. Christmas Day service at 1st Presbyterian at 10:30 AM. Worship times change in January to 9 AM at 1st and 10:30 AM at OS-TML. Shared Holy Week services with community churches if approved by Grue/Peace. Pastor's Compensation for 2025 of \$101,555 which was approved to pass on to churches by Shared Ministry, was voted approved by the Session to be passed on to be approved by the congregation at January Annual Meeting.

Buildings and Grounds: Jim Rylander was able to fix the kitchen faucet, no new materials needed.

Worship: Session agreed to purchase cake for December 8 WOW Christmas program day. Session voted to hold 3rd Sunday service upstairs in December (no Coffeehouse worship day). Christmas Day service will be at 10:30 am with communion, but no coffee that day.

Stewardship: Budget will be reviewed by Jim Risbrudt, Kim Bailey and Troy Johnson.

New Business: Starner Funds were voted to be distributed as required-50% local, 50% world mission. Local Mission: Union Cemetery: \$250, Pelican Lake Cemetery: \$250, Grant Co Food shelf: \$400, Ashby Backpack program: \$280, Group Cares \$200. World Mission: PEB (Pakistan Student) \$365, Haiti Eye Mission: \$200, Presbyterian World Mission: \$815.

Session voted approval to a request for use of facilities for a piano recital of students of Kris Williams the evening of December 15 at the church.

Next meeting: December 10, 2024 at 7 PM. The meeting was voted adjourned and closed with all praying the Lord's Prayer.
