From the Pastor's Desk

"And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

All members of the church are charged with this task of going and making disciples and teaching others to obey everything that Jesus has commanded. This is a huge task and that is why Jesus gave it to the whole church, not just pastors or elders or council members or teachers, but to everybody. We now livestream all of our services and it has been a blessing to connect with people who are unable to attend worship in person. Many people in care facilities, hospitals, snowbirds, or people who aren't able to attend worship in person for any reason are now able to attend virtually. This has been a real blessing to the church that we are not limited to reaching just the people in the sanctuary.

Our Shared Ministry has purchased another technology tool that can be a blessing to us and our families. The Shared Ministry has a subscription to RightNow media and every member of our church has <u>FREE</u> access to thousands of great faith resources. I hope many of you will take advantage of this. All you need to do is make an account. See the flyer in this newsletter and on church bulletin boards for how to access this resource.

Here is RightNow Media's mission statement...



Regular Session Meeting September 16, 2024

The regular Session meeting of the 1st Presbyterian Church of Ashby was held at 7 PM on September 16, 2024. Those present were the Moderator Rev. Dr. Paul Snyder, Ruling Elders: Troy Johnson, Donna Fay Grover, Ron Bowman, Kim Bailey and Gwyn Risbrudt, treasurer Jim Risbrudt and Clerk Barb Dewey. Absent with excuse Jim Rylander. The meeting was opened in prayer and reflections from the book "Sailboat Church" on being a Spirit led church by the Moderator Pastor Snyder. A quorum was present and Docket voted approved with additions.

Treasurer's Report: Checking: \$2,246.96, Savings: \$20,954.27, Memorial: \$3,317.12, Music: \$7,958.50, Dishwasher: \$2,033.96, L&L Camp: \$1,480.38, Grover Bible: \$401.57, Building/Maint \$6,697.95, Starner Memorial: \$2,094.48. Treasurer Jim reported insurance due in November will be a big expense with rates going up and deductible is increased. He is seeing savings in expenses with the new A/C- furnace system. The treasurer's report was voted approved. August Minutes were read and voted approved.

Pastor's Report: Communion celebrated at Sunday services by Rev. Dr. Paul Snyder on August 27, 2024 with 20 communicants and September 1, 2024 with 30 communicants and those on Facebook live. Pastor Snyder did 3 visitations. Led Bible Study at Ashby Living Center. Led Safe Church Teacher/Youth Training on August 28, 2024 as required by insurance. First Communion Class held September 11, 2024 at 6:30 PM. October 6th will be First communion.

New community Christian youth groups starting at school but also hope to have a group with churches as well-leadership is still needed.

Buildings and Grounds: Gwyn will check on painting along the ramps in the entry.

Christian Education: W.O.W. (Worship on Wednesday/Sunday school) schedule distributed-begins October 2. Little Lights (younger children Sunday School) will begin October 13. Confirmation class with parents will be September 18 at 6:30 PM.

Worship: Session voted approval of the Hanging of the Greens Service to be on December 8, 2024 which will be led by the WOW students.

Old Business: Habitat for Humanity -house coming to Dalton, cement will soon be poured in forms.
