From the Pastor's Desk

"However that may be, let each of you lead the life that the Lord has assigned, to which God called you. This is my rule in all the churches." 1 Corinthians 7:17

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

It is with a heavy heart that I write this article. As you know my beloved mom passed away in August. I really miss my mom as I talked to her most every night. She was my best friend and role model in faith and in life. She taught me that faith and life are connected. Faith should have an impact on how we live life in the secular world, and God's presence is not only within the four walls of the church when we gather, but God's presence is also in our daily lives.

The early church understood this. Jesus' ministry didn't just happen in the confines of the temple or synagogues. There are many stories about Jesus that happen in his every day life. The early church emphasized that faith was something to be lived out in the world. God claims our whole lives not just an hour on Sunday morning.

Both the Presbyterian and the Lutheran Church put an emphasis on vocation. What is vocation? Here are some definitions of vocation from the dictionary:

- a particular occupation, business, or profession; calling.
- a strong impulse or inclination to follow a particular activity or career.
- a divine call to God's service or to the Christian life.
- a function or station in life to which one is called by God.

Vocation certainly means our careers and God calls us to do different things. God calls all of us to serve God in the secular world. God also calls us to the vocation of family. We don't often think of that as a vocation but we serve God by caring for and spending time with our children, grandchildren or elderly parents. We serve God through service in the community, and that is a vocation as well. We even serve God in our leisure in how we love our neighbors.

This fall we will begin the Life of Faith Initiate in our congregations. This is not a new program but a paradigm shift. This paradigm shift focuses on what we do between Sundays rather than what we do inside the church. Worship should equip us to serve God in our every day lives. You can learn more about this initiative at www.lifeoffaith.info and on Sunday, September 14th we will watch an introductory video as part of our worship. The second Sunday of each month we will continue to use a video and learn more about this initiative. These worship services will feel more like a Bible study as we learn together as a congregation. It was not necessarily designed to be used in this way, but in our context, I feel this is the easiest and best way to get the information to our entire congregation. I hope you will join us as we enter into this journey to reclaim the mission and vocation that God gives us both as a community of faith and as individuals. Let us have opens minds, so that we can follow the Spirit not only when we are together, but as we go out into the mission field, which is the world and the community in which we have been placed. Let us serve God each and every day wherever we are. Thanks be to God!
